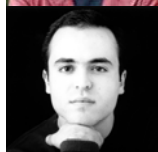
John Chen, Pianist

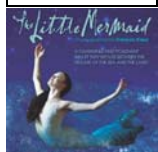
Tianwa Yang, Violinist

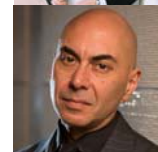
Edvard Tchivzhel, Conductor

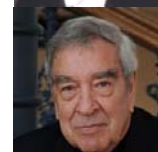
Michiyoshi Inoue, Conductor
